The entrants were National in the true sense of the word. The criteria for entering was that all parts used to manufacture the cars had to be produced in that country and the drivers had to be nationals of the country. The country that won, then ran the race the following year. Each country was allowed 3 entries.

1904 Gordon Bennett Race

The race was held in Germany on the Homburg Circuit. The race consisted of four laps of the circuit to make the total distance 527 km (327.46 miles) with speeds of up to 150 km/h (93 mph) being achieved.
